### Overview

ICANN is the Internet corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers. ICANN's mission is to help ensure a stable, secure, and unified global Internet. To reach another person on the Internet, you need to type an address – a name or a number – into your computer or other device. That address must be unique so computers know where to find each other. ICANN helps coordinate and support these unique identifiers across the world.

The LAC-i-Roadshow is one of the projects of the ICANN LAC Strategy, a strategy that was developed by the different stakeholder groups represented at ICANN from the Latin America and Caribbean region. It is designed to raise awareness across the region on key topics related to the Domain Name System (DNS) and critical infrastructure such as the transition to IPv6, SSR (Security, Stability and Resiliency), Universal Acceptance and the impact of the new Generic Top Level Domains (gTLD) program.
